FEES

We would prefer fees to be paid monthly by standing order as this does help our treasurer. However, we do have three payment options available to the junior section as outlined below:-

Payment Option	Price	What's included?
Monthly payment by standing order	£12 per month	This includes training sessions, matches and mini tournament. Affiliation will also be paid for every September if your daughter has been on standing order for more than 6 months prior to affiliation date
Cash (per session)	£3.50 per session	This includes training sessions, matches and mini tournament. Affiliation will be required to be paid by cheque in September
Cash (4 sessions paid in advance)	£12 per month	This includes training sessions, matches and mini tournament. Affiliation will be required to be paid by cheque in September

AFFILIATION

The England Netball insurance scheme is linked to Affiliation, and ensures that Registered Participants are covered for Civil Liability and Personal Accident Insurance. Affiliation is compulsory even if you are only training and is paid once a year.

This amount changes yearly, but for the 2009-10 season affiliation is £21. If you have been on standing order for more than 6 months prior to end August each year, this affiliation will be covered by your fees. If you pay by any other options, this will need to be paid by cash / cheque at the end of August each year

JUNIOR CLUB RULES

Roundwood Netball Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Sara Marsh.

As a member of Roundwood Netball Club, you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents / and their team mates.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform Sara Marsh if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit, which should include, at minimum, the following items:–

Matches

- Netball Skirt
- White polo shirt
- Suitable sports trainers

Training

- Netball Skirt / Shorts / Tracksuit Bottoms
- Suitable t-shirt
- Suitable sports trainers

- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

Do not rumble the thunder!

Treat team-mates, coaches, umpires and opponents with respect.

Have fun, reach for the top and always try your best.

Umpires are there to interpret the rules for you, accept their decisions.

Never use bad language or insult opponents, coaches or spectators.

Do not try to gain an unfair advantage over opponents.

Enjoy yourself; know the rules of netball and play by the spirit of the rules.

Realise that without your opponents; there wouldn't be a game.

Remember:

- A stranger is someone you do not know. You must never go anywhere with anyone you don't know. You must always ask your parents/guardian if it is OK to go with someone.
- Other people (even relations) are not always good. They can hurt, bully and upset young people, so you must be very careful. Good adults do not ask young people to keep secrets. You must tell.
- If you tell your parents/guardian or coach that you are going somewhere, you should always go there. If you change your mind you should let them know before you go.
- Your body belongs to you and the parts of your body that are covered by a swimming costume are private and shouldn't be touched. Sometimes a doctor or nurse might have to touch there, but your parents/guardian must always be there. If not, you can ask for someone else to be there.
- If anyone does anything you don't like, you must tell an adult that you can trust. If they don't believe you, you must tell another adult until you are believed.
- You should know your address and telephone number, and know how to make a reversed charge telephone call should you need picking up or are in any sort of trouble.
- If your parents/guardian send someone to pick you up from training or matches, they should use a secret code word that your parents/guardian and you have arranged. Your parents/guardian should let the coaches know when someone other than them is collecting you.
- If you see a friend getting into a car or going off with a stranger, you must not go near enough for them to get you, but you should shout and tell them not to go, and then go and tell an adult.
- It is always OK to say NO to someone, even a grown-up, who is trying to make you feel uncomfortable.
- Shout and run away if someone frightens you or follows you. Go towards places where there are people, or knock on someone's door and ask for help.
- Remember keeping safe is the important thing. You can break normal rules in order to stay safe.

CHILD PROTECTION POLICY STATEMENT

Roundwood Netball Club is committed to ensuring that all young people who play sport have a safe and positive experience. The club is committed to developing and implementing policies and procedures which ensure that everyone knows and accepts their responsibility in relation to a duty of care for young people.

Roundwood Netball Club recognises that it is not the responsibility of those individuals working within the club to determine if abuse has taken place, but it is their responsibility to act upon and report any concerns.

If any person within the club has a doubt to this policy's relevance to their role and duties then please contact Clare Russell, the Child Welfare Officer for Roundwood Netball Club.

The Club and those involved with the club will abide to the following principles and statements:

- All young people within Roundwood Netball Club, regardless of age, gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, ability or disability, have the right to be protected
- All young people participating in sport have a right to do so in a safe environment
- Adults working at Roundwood Netball Club will provide a safe, positive and fun sporting experience for young people
- Adults – volunteers, coaches and officials will understand and be supported in their role and responsibility with regard to the Duty of Care for young people
- All suspicions and allegations will be taken seriously, managed and dealt with swiftly and appropriately
- It is the responsibility of the child protection experts to determine whether or not abuse has taken place, but it is the responsibility of all those working within Roundwood Netball Club to report any concerns
- The club will assist coaches, volunteers and officials to remain up-to-date with the latest Child Protection issues
- The club will appoint a Child Welfare Officer whose role is to be responsible for issues concerning child welfare at the club
- The club will carry out regular risk assessments to ensure the safety of young people and all members of the club
